

# Important changes

## **Bye-Law 4.4.2. – Intention to Enter Form.**

An organizing Federation cancelling or changing the date or venue of an E&A Titled event less than two months before the original date on the Calendar, becomes responsible for reimbursing any substantiated expenses necessarily incurred by Federations who have sent in time an ‘Intention to Enter’ form for the Championships.

For all E&A Titled Events the E&A office will send an ‘Intention to Enter’ form to the Federations. This ‘Intention to Enter’ form has to be returned to the organizing Federation and to the E&A divisional council representative to the event with a deadline of two months before the start of the competition.

A Federation entering a team (even of only one skier) after that deadline, will be fined 200 Euro.

**To be accepted, the “Intention to Enter” form must be accompanied by a deposit amounting to 50 Euro for each athlete mentioned on the form. (For instance : 3 athletes :3x50 = 150 Euro).**

**This amount must be paid to the organisers and is non-refundable.**

**This 50 Euro will be deducted from the entry fee to be paid for each athlete.**

**The Federation may enter up to two additional athletes more than originally declared on the “Intention to Enter” form. If more than two additional athletes participate, then a fee of 50 Euro per additional athlete will be levied upon that Federation.**

## **Bye-Law 4.5.1.6. Team or individual athletes not showing up**

**The entry fees of team or individual athletes failing to show up after having been entered by their Federation shall still be payable in full, unless a valid written excuse is received by 12 noon of the day before the start of the competition.**

## **2016 TOURNAMENT ADDITIONAL RULES**

### **1.12. Video/ End course picture**

All video footage becomes the property of Europe & Africa Confederation and shall be kept in the custody of the Chief Judge during the competition. The videos required are the originals from the boat camera in tricks and the end course camera in slalom (not copies made on the tower). Video will be recorded on digital media and files for trick, must be .avi type. Analogue VHS media is no longer accepted.

For all RL & RC competitions, all End Course Slalom videos must be submitted to the E&A TC.

In addition, for titled and elite events, Jump End Course and Trick videos should also be submitted to the E&A TC.

It is the responsibility of the Chief Judge to ensure that the Organiser submits these videos to the E&A TC within 30 days from the end of the competition. Failure to send the tapes after 31st October will result in the site not being permitted to hold an Homologated event the following year.

There are 2 ways to do submit the video to the TC:

1) The organiser can upload the files directly to the E&A storage server. This is a straight forward solution and is the preferred option. A step by step guide on how to do this can be found in Appendix F.

### **4.3. Teams**

**Each Federation may enter a Team composed of a maximum of 6 skiers with a maximum of 4 of the same sex.**
